
## TUB/SHOWER OR SHOWER

R702.3.7 Water resistant gypsum board (greenboard) is allowed in tub or shower compartment for adhesive application of ceramic tile or other required nonabsorbent finish material.

Water-resistant gypsum board shall not be installed over a class I or II vapor retarder in a shower or tub compartment.

Vapor barrier not allowed behind water resistant gypsum board

> Water resistant gypsum board allowed at soaking tub surround with no shower fixture

Backer Board Materials - Table R702.4.2

- Glass mat gypsum backing panel
- fiber-reinforced gypsum panels
- Nonasbestos fiber-cement backer board
- Nonasbestos fiber mat reinforced cementious backer units



## Water-resistant gypsum backing board.

SOAKING OR JETTED TUB

- Use shall be permitted on ceilings where framing does not exceed 12" o.c. for  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch and 16" o.c. for  $\frac{5}{8}$ ".
- 2. It shall not be installed over a vapor retarder in a tub or shower compartment.
- It shall not be used where there will be direct exposure to water, or in areas subject to continuous high humidity, per R702.3.7.1
- Install per manufacturer's recommendations.
